Dear Parents and Carers,

### Covid update

As the Government have updated their guidance for 'Living with Covid' and symptomatic testing (PCR) and asymptomatic testing (LFT) has now ceased for the majority of the population, I am writing to outline how these changes will affect procedures in school. Children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature and they feel well enough to attend. This would be the usual procedure you would follow as parents and carers for any illness.

If you still have lateral flow test kits at home and have tested your child and they are found to be positive, they should stay at home for **3 days** and avoid contact with others. They should then return to school and normal activities after that time if they are well enough and provided they no longer have a temperature.

School will continue to remain vigilant to the signs of Covid-19 and will continue with our enhanced hygiene measures, as has been the case throughout the whole pandemic. We will also keep areas well ventilated by letting air in. Should we see a sudden increase in illness linked to Covid symptoms we will continue to seek advice from Public Health.

We hope this update is helpful in outlining our response to the updated guidance.
