Dear Parents and Carers,

Transition

With the end of year fast approaching, it is time for us to prepare children for transition into their new year group.

For those children in Year 6, most visits to new schools are being held virtually this year, although parents will be contacted by individual secondary schools to confirm their procedures.

For our other children, we have thought very carefully about how to arrange visits to new teachers this year in the safest possible way. We feel it is very important to go ahead with visits to new classes so that children have the opportunity to meet their new teachers. It is especially important for those children in Years 1-5, where we are splitting classes. *Please note - we are not splitting Reception classes.*

Children will therefore visit their new teacher tomorrow - Wednesday 30th June - and will spend the day completing activities to support transition and get to know one another. All being well, we will have further transition opportunities the following week.

Once children have met their new teachers, you will soon find that the current Learning Platform Year Group pages will be taken over by the new teachers. We will upload short videos where you will be able to see your child's new teacher and new areas of the school, photos of staff and shared stories. There will not be any homework set on OneNote - instead there will be discussions and activities set on the Year Group pages by the new teachers which we would encourage your child to engage with.
