### Parking Issues

As you are aware, parking around the school site, in particular on Raeburn Road is an ongoing issue. Whilst the majority of our parents do park and behave in a considerate manner we are facing issues from a small number. We are asking all parents and carers to work with us, and each other, to ensure the safety of all our pupil's. Whilst parking around the school site is a law enforcement issue and school has no jurisdiction over parking disputes, we will continue to make contact with the Police and the Local Council and will always follow their advice. Please see below a letter provided by West Midlands Police to local schools regarding the importance of parking sensibly.

You may have seen a traffic warden issuing tickets around the school site recently and also the CCTV enforcement vehicle driving around at peak times, using automatic number plate recognition to issue fines directly to the offenders. The fines issued by the CCTV enforcement vehicles are not parking tickets stuck to cars so it will not be immediately obvious to our parents that action has been taken, however we can assure parents fines have been issued.

Whilst we hope the fines will have an impact, please can we ask parents to park considerately at all times and perhaps consider parking a short walk away from school to ease congestion. We would also like to remind parents that parking or stopping to drop off/pick up children on the yellow zig zag lines between 8:00am - 9:30am and 2:30pm - 4:00pm, Monday to Friday is **not permitted** as per the signage.

The car park entrance on Wimperis Way must not be obstructed at any time and must be kept clear for school deliveries and emergency access.

Please note that everything in place is for the safety of our children, parents, carers and visitors.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to remind you of the importance of parking vehicles sensibly, with consideration to residents and the safety of other road users and pedestrians.

We ask that when parking your vehicle you make sure you are not obstructing driveways of local residents, causing obstructions to other vehicles and parking inconsiderately.

Parking inconsiderately can cause collisions, pedestrians to be in danger and obstruct emergency service vehicles.

We will be taking action with anyone that fails to show consideration and continues to park illegally. This will include issuing tickets for wilful obstruction, unnecessary obstruction and leaving a vehicle in a dangerous position. These can carry fines and possible points on your license.

We hope that there will be no need to issue tickets and that parking will be done safely and considerately in future.
