‘Creating a SMART Collaborative Classroom’ has been developed to support teachers in the quest to enhance the teaching and learning process that takes place in their classroom and beyond, with the implementation of SMART technology to help ‘inspire greatness’.

This course will start with the final outcome. There will be a tour of the school focusing not only on Europe’s first collaborative classroom but also how this approach has been replicated across the school in a manageable and meaningful way. You will hear the journey the school has experienced and be able to ask questions. Together we will define what classroom collaboration looks like and you will learn how to develop it further through the use of devices being used by the children in your everyday teaching. SMART Lab activities will be explored (device led) and the SLSO workspace focusing on collaboration and differentiation. You will be asked to analyse a collaborative lesson and provide feedback. There is a content creation task that will be fulfilled by all delegates during the training day focusing on collaboration, student engagement and device integration into future medium term planning. (Each delegate will be expected to bring a medium term plan from their school with them)

Please note there is a pre-training course that must be completed online prior to attending this course. Details will be shared once booking has been completed. Delegates who have already accessed Course 2 will automatically gain a place. Post training delegates will have the opportunity to apply to become a SMART Exemplary Educator after the completion of this course.

Pheasey Park Farm Primary School is one of only a few recognised Smart Exemplary Schools in the UK. We will include a tour of our school within the training enabling you to see Europe’s first collaborate classroom in full use as well as watching live lessons that are enhanced in quality through the use of SMART technologies and trained staff.
